Ministry of Education, Govt. of India successfully piloted AEDPs in 20 colleges (15 Logistics & 5 Retail) in AY 2018-19.

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
BBA (Logistics) & BBA (Retail) were offered with 60% skill content and 40% general & compulsory content, and final two semesters for industry apprenticeship.


- 21 Colleges from 07 Universities received AEDP implementation approvals.






Mapping Academic Schedules with Admission Schedules
