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- Centre for Research in Schemes and Policies (CRISP) committed to work with the Government of Meghalaya on two aspects:
 - ✚ Improving Learning and facilitating effective implementation of NEP 2020 and Meghalaya State education Policy 2018 and
 - ✚ Design and implement the Rural Development 3.0 projects.

Education Sector

❖ School Need to be reorganized:

- i. As per CRISP recommendation on Rationalization of Schools district wise mapping of schools by distant has been started. Criteria and Guidelines will be framed and submitted as they wanted to route this through the State Education Commission.
- ii. Education Minister wanted CRISP to conduct an extensive project for collection of robust data relating to Schools. Discussion underway between the two party.

EDUCATION SECTOR

- ❖ **HR teacher of Schools needs to be address**
 - i. Proposed note on “District Cadre” has been submitted and discussion underway.
Comments from State Education Commission awaited.

EDUCATION SECTOR

❖ Strengthen Governance & Organisational restructuring:

- i. CRISP recommended on redefining roles and Responsibilities of DSEL, Samagra Shiksha, DERT and MBOSE. Presentation has been made to the State Education Commission on the 1st August 2023 as Govt of Meghalaya wanted this to be routed through the commission.
- As per the suggestions by CRISP, The Government of Meghalaya has sent out a letter to the Government of India seeking permission for redirecting NCTE to allow IGNOU to carry out one-time in-service training programme. As approval awaited, an alternative Solutions has also been proposed by CRISP for a project mode competency-based certified courses for Teachers to be run by DERT. Proposal under preparation and will be submitted soon for approval.

EDUCATION SECTOR

- ❖ **Enhance student learning Outcome:**
 - i. A study on dropout is being carried by CRISP Team
 - ii. Meeting will be held on the 1st Sept 2023 with DERT Assessment Team to further discuss on assessment framework.
 - iii. A meeting with Social Welfare Department and ECD Mission has been held on the 31st August for discussion on Quality ECCE, Integrating ECCE with FLN and for ensuring that all students entering grade 1 are school ready.

EDUCATION SECTOR

❖ **Effective Implementation of New Education Policy 2020:**

- i. After the presentation made by Central Square Foundation, the Government of Meghalaya has agreed on the “Structured Pedagogy Workshop for FLN”. The proposal for the workshop has been submitted and the file is under process. Tentative dates will be 19th - 21th Sept 2023.
- ii. Draft Proposal for Vocational Education Workshop is in the process of preparation.
- iii. Madam Sandhya was chosen as expert to review on State ECCE Curriculum.

RURAL DEVELOPMENT

❖ Institutional Building of SHG network-

- i. Development Commissioner already flag off formation of 5000 more SHGs in the State
- ii. Discussion underway for identification of CRPs to reach out and train for SHG peer group support in order to strengthening SHGs.

Rural development

❖ Improving Credit Availability of SHGs

- i. Exposure Visit to Stree Nidhi, Telangana with MSRLS Team to conduct an indepth study
- ii. Proposal Draft for setting up an APEX Specialized Women Financial Institutions has been presented before the Development Commissioner and other Departmental Officaials.
- iii. Submitted Final Draft of Detailed Project Report (DPR) to Development Secretary, Sir Sampath Kumar, IAS for Cabinet approval
- iv. CEO, MSRLS has already been held and mobilization of CLFS will begin from first Week September to bring all respective body on board so that registration can be held soon as approval comes.

Rural Development

❖ Focus on Livelihood

- i. Livelihood Model draft is under study and a proposal will be prepared
- ii. Agreed to Collaborate with Smart Village Movement (SVM) the implementing agencies to work on both Education sectors and Rural Development and help in recommending their scaling of successful Projects.
- iii. In consultation with Smart Village Movement (SVM) team to develop strategies for livelihood program activities

- ❖ **Convergence with other Programme and SDGs for SHGs**
 - i. As per inputs from Sir Vijayanand, Proposal Draft for stating the “School of Practice” which will act as Model Villages for the preparation of VLDP:GPDP is prepared.

 - iii. Once the draft is finalized will discussed with Sir Sampath, development commissioner and Sir Sibhi, IAS, Director C&RD
