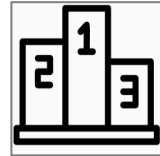

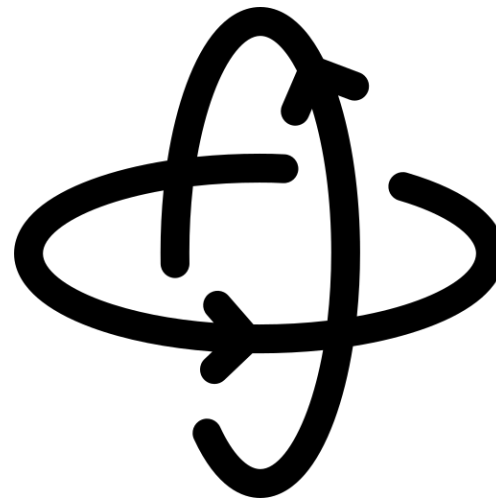
Incapacity to prepare Action Plan

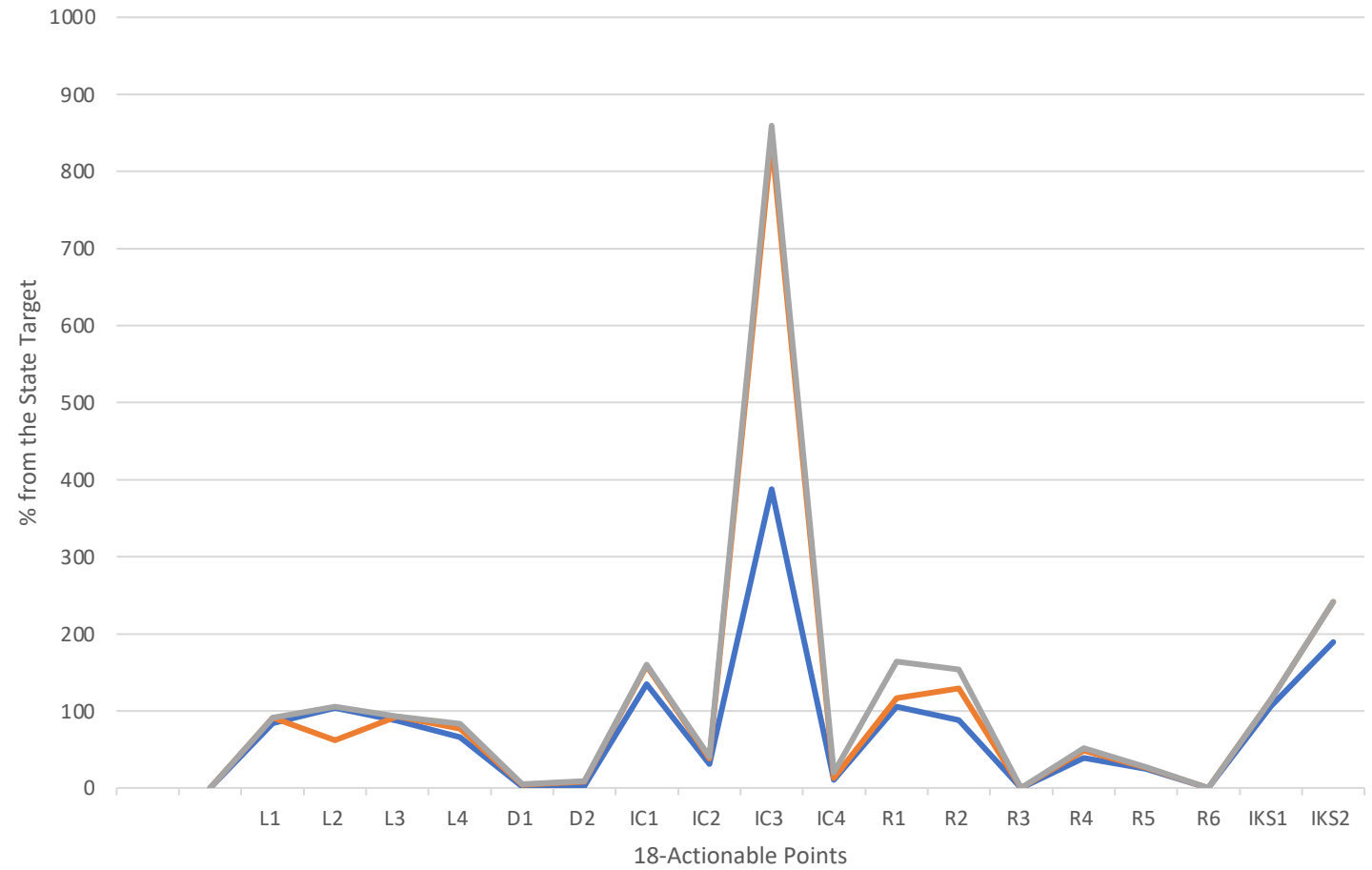

Objective

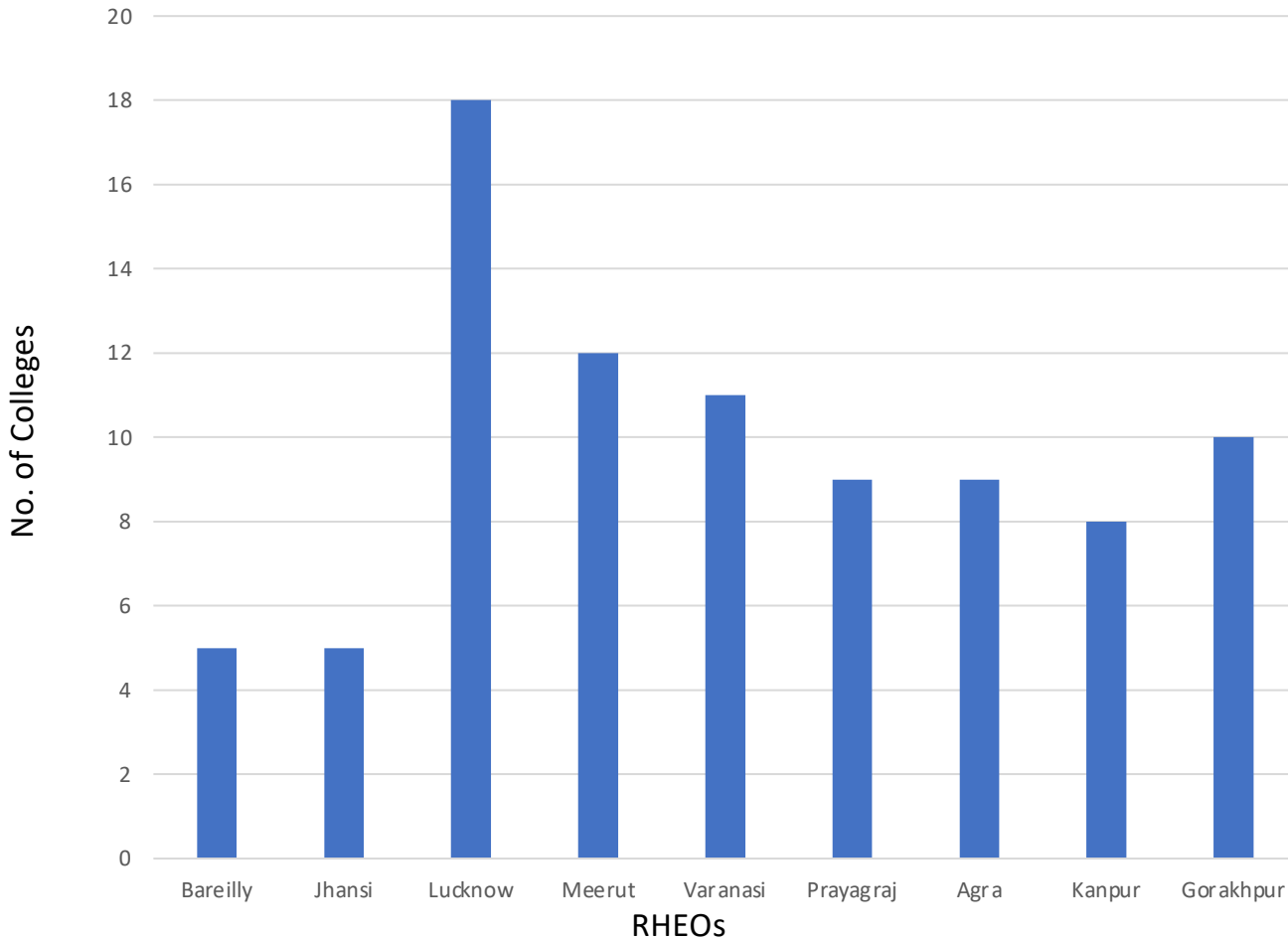

Action Plan



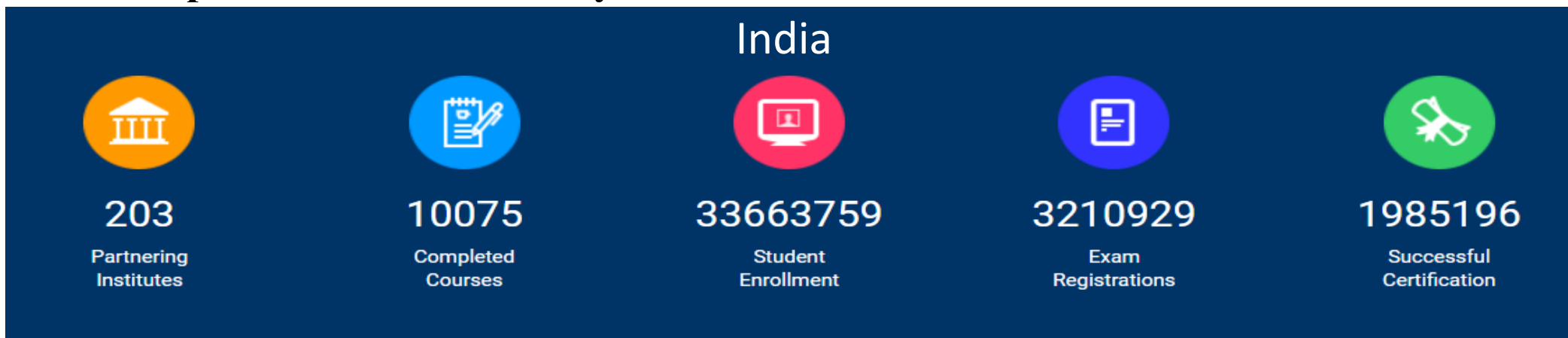
- Identify faculty interested in participating in the project.

- Monitor their progress till they reach publication in SCOPUS or CARE journals.



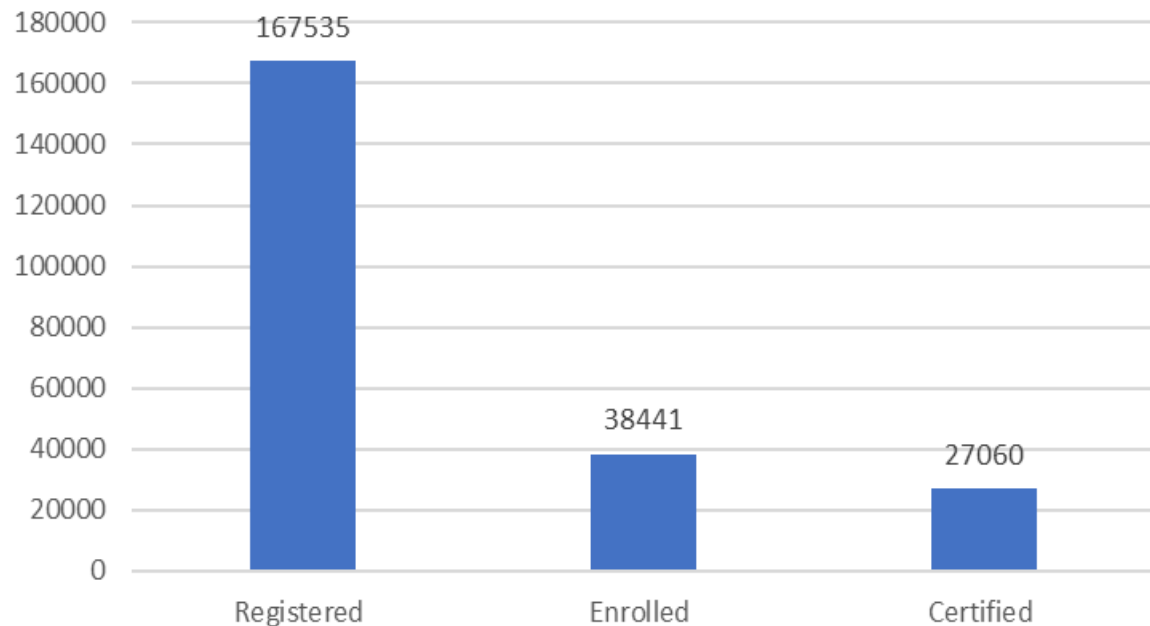
